## What This Is

A simple format for founders applying to **Build With Me / Founder Studio**. A short, honest one-page note tells more than a polished deck. This is selective, equity-aligned collaboration — not a job, not paid consulting, not guaranteed funding.

## Send These 8 Points

01. **Your name & background** — who you are, what you've built or studied

02. **What are you building?** — one clear sentence

03. **What problem are you solving?** — and why it matters now

04. **Who is the customer?** — the specific person/segment

05. **What have you already done?** — progress, not just plans

06. **Any traction?** — prototype, revenue, waitlist, community

07. **What do you need from me?** — direction, structure, capital strategy, network

08. **Why should we build together?** — the fit, in your words

## What Makes a Strong Note

- Clear problem, not a vague idea
- Evidence you've done the thinking
- Honesty about what's not working
- Real progress over polish
- Long-term intent, not quick vanity
- You can execute consistently

Please don't send only **"I have an idea."** Send enough context to make the first conversation useful. If there's a fit, the next step is about structure, direction and alignment — not motivation.
